(put this paper into paper bags)

If paper items are mixed in with cans, bottles or other kinds of recycling items, then nothing will be collected.

- ALL large items listed above must be cut down to the size of a folded newspaper, then placed in paper bags or tied in a bundle.
- Please DON'T use PLASTIC bags!

For 2025 the trash collection fee for each residence or apartment is \$280. Please keep this flier until the end of 2025

When it is & how much to put out:

- Put your trash out the night before your Collection Day.
- Trash District Collection will be on a MONDAY.
- BUT if New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving or Christmas fall on a MONDAY, THEN TRASH COLLECTION WILL BE ON TUESDAY.
- Six (6) bags or cans of trash will be collected per residence or apartment.
- One (1) bulk item can be put out for trash collection each week.

These items will NOT be collected:

- Appliances (large items)
- Automotive tires
- Construction debris
- Construction materials
- Hazardous materials
- Items containing Freon
- Oil-based or Specialty Paints

Branches, Sticks, Shrubs & Cuttings:

- MUST be bundled and tied together
- Maximum length four (4) feet long
- Must not weigh more than 40 pounds

Christmas trees: Please take to the Twp Drop-off area on Hilltop Rd

Leaves:

- Keep leaves separate from branches and sticks.
- Keep leaf piles away from parked cars.
- Please do not throw leaves into the trash!
- Leaves will not be vacuumed in the Spring, ONLY in the Fall.
- For Spring collections both leaves and garden residue MUST be placed in BIODEGRADABLE bags
